## What Is CSRA Kids?


CSRA Kids is a digital family resource that connects parents across the Augusta Metro and Aiken County regions with events, activities, camps, parks, and local businesses.

# CSRA Kids Teacher Appreciation Program

The CSRA Kids Teacher Appreciation Program is a community-funded initiative that celebrates and supports the educators who make our schools stronger.

Each month, a portion of the proceeds from the CSRA Kids Family Club and business sponsorships is used to recognize one local teacher through meaningful classroom support and community recognition.

This program was designed to make appreciation tangible, joyful, and community-driven.

## How the Program Works

Families and businesses support the CSRA Kids Family Club.

- A portion of those proceeds is set aside for the Teacher Appreciation Fund.
- One teacher is selected each month through a school-aligned process.
- The teacher receives classroom support and recognition as part of a community celebration.

This approach ensures teachers are recognized in ways that are practical, positive, and meaningful for both educators and students.

## How the Program Works

Teachers shape the daily lives of our children and families. The CSRA Kids Teacher Appreciation Program helps ensure that educators feel valued and supported by the community they serve.

By connecting families, businesses, and schools, the program creates a visible reminder that when we support teachers, we strengthen the entire community.

## What the Program Provides

Each month, CSRA Kids selects a local teacher to receive:

- A classroom pizza party celebration
- A student prize box for classroom rewards
- A teacher appreciation stipend or gift
- Public recognition through CSRA Kids platforms

The program rotates across local school districts throughout the CSRA to ensure broad and equitable community support.



# CSRA Kids Grant Fulfillment Program

The CSRA Kids Grant Fulfillment Program helps nonprofit organizations, public agencies, and community initiatives meet grant-required outreach, engagement, and participation goals by leveraging the trusted CSRA Kids family platform. Rather than building outreach systems from scratch, organizations can partner with CSRA Kids to connect directly with local families through a trusted, established community network.

CSRA Kids serves as a non-clinical, non-service-delivery outreach partner, helping grant-funded programs reach the families they are designed to serve.
