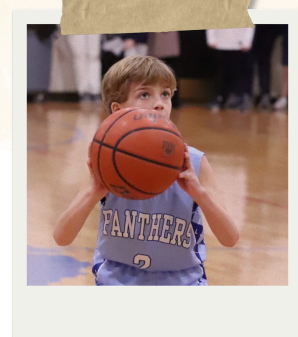

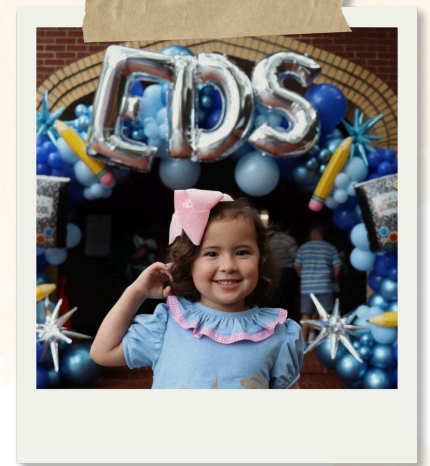

## Video Game Design

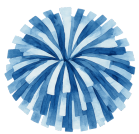
